## An education for all – Graduation House grand opening!



It was standing room only when over 55 international guests joined a throng of locals to celebrate the official opening of Awareness Cambodia's Graduation House complex on 7 September 2014 by Secretary of State of the Ministry of Social Affairs, Labour, Vocational Training and Youth Rehabilitation, His Excellency Nim Thoth.

The opening was attended by dignitaries from around the world, including representatives of the Cambodian and Australian governments, corporate and not-for-profit sectors, business and community leaders. Simon Fellows, First Secretary and Deputy Head of Mission Australia, read a letter of support from Australian Foreign Minister, the Honourable Julie Bishop.

### Fast Facts

- Graduation House comprises three buildings with the highest point at 14.72 metres above ground level.
- Features over 2200 square metres of tiling.
- 500 cubic metres of concrete was needed to construct the building.
- The building has been specifically designed to accommodate an additional two storeys to house another 40 students as numbers increase.

Nearly 4 years in the making, this million dollar, state-of-the-art facility – the largest of its kinds in Cambodia – is a home-away-from-home for our students undertaking further vocational or academic studies at campuses in the capital, Phnom Penh. Many of the students have been supported through our child development projects at Sunshine House and House of Progress and today are at the final stage of their educational journey – Graduation House, which is helping to empower them to take their places in Cambodian society.

The site is now home to a four-storey complex across three separate buildings: an administrant on block for staff training and meetings; and two residential facilities – one for students, the other for international volunteer staff. The student building features a communal kitchen, dining area, recreation space, computer lab, laundry, outdoor kitchen and garage on the ground floor. There is an additional common area on the top storey.

Each room is home to two young people and features a single bunk bed, two study desks, a built-in cupboard, an en-suite and storage space.



## Message from the Minister for Foreign Affairs, The Hon Julie Bishop, on the occasion of the opening of Graduation House, Phnom Penh – 7 September 2014



I am very proud of the efforts of two organisations from my home town of Perth – Awareness Cambodia and the Australian Rules football club, the West Coast Eagles (of which I am a former director) – that have led to this opening ceremony today, and grateful for the support the project has received from Cambodian Government Ministries and many others.

Education plays an important role in both personal growth and in enabling individuals to rise above poverty. Young people who are fortunate enough to benefit from Graduation House and Awareness Cambodia’s ongoing support at the tertiary level will have exciting opportunities open up to them and I am confident they will go on to make a positive contribution to the future of Cambodia.

Education is also an important tool for establishing people-to-people links and research collaboration between countries. From the 1950s students from Cambodia studied in Australia under the previous Colombo Plan. I recently announced Cambodia’s participation in the New Colombo Plan which will provide opportunities for Australian students to live, work and study in your country and build networks and friendships that will last a lifetime.

I offer my warmest congratulations on the opening of this new facility which will provide a secure environment for students to flourish and achieve their goals.
